Qualifications to include but not limited to:

- Strong connections with A.A. members from Haitian Kreyòl and/or Haitian communities throughout the U.S./Canada service structure.
- High fluency and reading comprehension of Haitian Kreyòl.
- Fluency in English.
- An understanding of how A.A. language may best translate to Haitian Kreyòl.
- Experience and familiarity with the A.A. literature.
- A minimum of two years sobriety.
- Ability to collaborate and work with others.

- Time Commitment of 6 to 12 months.
